**PURPOSE** The Pur Java Coffee Scholarship Program was established in 2015. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals enrolled for undergraduate study in community colleges, colleges, trade schools and universities. The Pur Java Coffee Scholarship principally targets two and four year academic programs; however, certificate/licensing programs including but not limited to fields such as paralegal training, IT, ultrasound techs, medical records personnel and nursing are also eligible.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is based on financial need, leadership potential, and participation in Pur Java Coffee programs including but not limited to volunteer hours. Scholarships are awarded and/ or renewed annually provided funds are available. In addition, the scholarship may be renewed provided the award recipient meets the conditions outlined below in *Scholarship Renewal*.

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Pur Java Coffee awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. The Pur Java Coffee Scholarship pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. Scholarships are awarded each semester and will be continued each semester if the student maintains a 2.5 GPA and continues to qualify each semester. The Pur Java Coffee Scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

### CRITERIA

- Applicants must have permanent residence status in the state of Nebraska.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college, university, or trade school program for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.
- Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
- Preference may be given to applicants who have participated in Pur Java Coffee programs.

### **CRITERIA** Continued.

- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Student must apply for the current year Federal Student Aid Application (FAFSA).
- Student must submit a copy of their current year Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by 2nd Monday, in June for Fall Semester
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by 2nd Monday, in November for Spring Semester
- Scholarship recipients will receive their check for the next semester **only** after their grades from the previous semester have been received.

### TIMELINE

- 7. Both new and renewal applications are due 2nd Monday, in June and 2nd Monday in November at 5:00 p.m. CST (NO EXCEPTIONS)
  - Candidates that are eligible for interviews will be notified by the Scholarship Committee by 2nd Monday, in July for the Fall Semester and 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday, in December for Spring Semester.
  - Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by 4th Monday, in July for Fall Semester and 4th Monday, in November for Spring Semester.

# Application Process

### NEW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution.
- Two academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A 3,500-word essay on how we can improve one of our products in the market.
- A photo of you holding one of our products.
- A copy of the original receipt of purchase.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies.
- Demonstrated financial need.

### SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Scholarships may be renewed annually if entering a full time program, and up to four times for a total of 4 years of study, if recipients maintain a 2.5 average GPA and complete required volunteer hours. More than 4 renewals may be considered on a case-by-case basis. This presupposes that funds are available for disbursement.
- The scholarship recipient must demonstrate need for continued financial assistance.
- A personal statement describing their experience during their academic year and what they have learned that will help them move forward in life.
- Completed application form.
- The Scholarship recipient must retain permanent residence status in the state of Nebraska.
- Students must provide a transcript for consideration. Students may provide a transcript printed from an online college record through the prior semester or an official transcript. Awards will be made provisionally pending receipt of final grades from fall or spring semester of that year.

 Renewal applications are due by 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday, in June for Fall Semester and 2nd Monday, in November for Spring Semester

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Award notification will be given by 4th Monday, in July for Fall Semester and 4th Monday, in November for Spring Semester.
- Applicant must provide their student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be received.
- Award amounts will be distributed each semester after a student's final grades are received by Pur Java Coffee Program

### **CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS**

- All recipients must apply for a Pell Grant.
- If applicant is awarded a scholarship, twenty-four volunteer hours per academic year must be worked in Pur Java Coffee Community Programs.
- All scholarship recipients will coordinate a plan for how they will meet their service requirement with the Pur Java Coffee Programs Volunteer Coordinator after accepting the scholarship and before beginning their college studies.
- Scholarship recipients will receive their check for the next semester only after their grades from the previous semester have been received. Students must receive a 2.5 grade point average based on a 4.0 scale.
- Deadline for the application is 2nd Monday, in June for Fall Semester and 2nd Monday, in November for Spring Semester
- Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
